



Code of Conduct for Teachers

Responsibilities of Teachers

- Those whoever adopts teaching profession, should themselves follow code conduct accordance with the ideals of the profession. A teacher is constantly under the surveillance of their students and society at large. Therefore, the teachers shall always try to become ideal for their students.
- Should explore to make professional growth continuous through study, training and research project.
- Teachers should complete the syllabus in time. Teachers shall produce good results in the subjects handled by them and are accountable for the same.
- Perform their duties in the form of teaching practical, seminar and university examination duties as assigned to them.
- Teachers should maintain decorum both inside and outside the classroom and set a good example to the students.
- Advance teaching programme should be submitted in the beginning of the session to the Principal.
- Participate in extension, extra-curricular activities including community services.
- Teachers must report in time to duty as per the working hours prescribed and should be available in the campus unless and otherwise they are assigned duties elsewhere.
- Not more than 25% of staff members in a Department will be allowed to go on OD/CL on a particular day.
- Teachers are encouraged to write text books, publish articles in reputed Journals and present papers in Seminars and Conferences at least 1 in an academic year.
- No teacher should involve himself/herself in any act of moral pravity on his/her part which may cause impairment or bring discredit to the institution or Management.
- No teacher should involve himself or herself in any form of political activity inside the campus.
- Any Instructions issued by the Management by way of Circulars from time to time must be complied with.
